## A Little About the NWR Fiddle Contest

The *Northwest Regional Fiddle Contest* started in 1969 in Spokane, at Trent Elementary School. This year's contest, the 54th annual, will be held at Players and Spectators in Spokane Valley, WA.

This contest is one of the largest of its kind in the area. It includes contestants from: Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana, North Dakota, South Dakota, Wyoming, Alaska, British Columbia, Alberta & Saskatchewan, and more. Some of the top national fiddlers, as well as many state and regional champions, will be competing in the eight certified fiddle divisions at this year's two-day affair. Fiddling spans many generations and brings all ages together for one amazing activity.

The divisions are: Small Fry (under 9), Junior - Junior (under 13), Junior (under 18), Young Adult (18 – 36), Adult (37 – 59), Senior and Senior - Senior (60 +), and the Championship Open. The winners of each division will be certified for the National Old-time Fiddle Contest in Weiser, Idaho (held the third week in June each year).

Each contestant plays three tunes per round: a hoe-down, a waltz, and a third tune of their choice (other than a hoe-down or a waltz). No tune can be repeated by a contestant during the contest, and each round must be kept under four minutes of playing time or points are deducted from the contestant's score. All this is combined for exciting listening and high-powered competition.

The Northwest Regional Fiddle Contest is being presented by the Northwest Regional Fiddle Contest Committee and other volunteers. We are a non-profit organization.

Our objectives are:

- To promote and perpetuate old-time fiddling, bluegrass, and folk music.
- To encourage young people to develop their music talents and afford them opportunities to perform in public thereby improving their spiritual, mental, social, and physical condition; thus, better preparing themselves for become successful citizens.
- To hold jam sessions for the members' own enjoyment, as well as educating the public to the values of this type of entertainment through observation.
